Payment and Fees

Online Homework will be suspended after 1-week of non-payment.

In the case that a Service Order is not requested *prior to the billing date*, a reminder will be sent, the student has 3 days to make payment, or the tutoring appointments and online course for the following month will be cancelled.

Online Class and past learning records are deleted after 1-month of non-payment.

Please Note that the part time tutoring with online curriculum includes the following benefits:

Weekly tutoring session(s) reserved for the student / group

Lessons and practice homework questions tailored to the students' learning goals

Cancellation/ No-Attendance Policy

Parents/ Students pay for the tutoring session even if they cancel a session. If a tutoring session is canceled by the student, make-up session will not be given. Payment for monthly math sessions secures your time slot.

I am not obligated to reschedule a session not attended by the student for any reason (i.e. school or sport events, birthday parties, extracurricular activities, field trips, medical appointments, family vacations, schedule conflicts, forgotten tutoring sessions, or lack of preparation for tutoring sessions.)

Lessons cancelled by me will always be rescheduled or credited.

Payment for a non-attended tutoring session will not be refunded.

If the student decides to discontinue tutoring, any fees already paid will not be refunded.

Arriving Late to Tutoring

Students should arrive on time for their scheduled tutoring session. Tutoring will end at the appointed time even if the student is late.

If a student arrives late, a make-up session will not be offered.

Please respect the time I put into preparing for tutoring lessons and being available for the student(s).

Tutoring session times are scheduled on the website in the "Math Tutoring" Scheduler. For students who commit to attend weekly, I will reserve the same time each week unless we agree to temporarily or permanently change the lesson time.

Other Policies

Tutoring fees are charged per student. Lesson fees are set to cover the cost of the lesson as well as preparing the online curriculum.

I, as the teacher, reserve the right to terminate a student for frequent missed lessons, frequent late or missed tuition payments, regular lack of effort or completion of assignments, or poor behavior during lessons.

Students who temporarily withdraw from lessons are not guaranteed a reinstatement, nor are refunded for any paid lessons.

My commitment to you

I will maintain a professional classroom environment and provide math instruction that is both nurturing and challenging.

I will tailor instruction to match the student's specific learning goals, communicate dates and times in advance, be on time to each tutoring session.

I will provide continuous feedback during the semester. As necessary, we can schedule a parent homeschool consultation/choice navigator appointment to discuss the progress in more detail.

Student Commitment

Students should log in and complete individualized lessons at least 4-5 times a week. Each lesson should be completed to at least 90%.

During tutoring, students will correct their assignments to 100%.

Work towards understanding all the concepts of math, since math builds on each concept. Come prepared to each lesson. Student should have their notebook, computer, a writing tool. Algebra 1 and above students are required to have a TI-84 Plus CE graphing calculator or access to Desmos graphing calculator online. (Please consult with me to confirm you are purchasing the correct version of the calculator)

Students should keep distracting items out of the tutoring environment.

Arrive on time to each scheduled tutoring session.

Parent Commitment

Students should practice math 5 days a week. I know that family commitments can make it difficult for children to complete their required work. Please be in prayer regarding the commitments you make, as everything on the schedule will influence your children's success. Keep these thoughts in mind. If a child completes math 4 days a week, they will complete 80% of the course during the school year. There is the possibility that they will fall behind, thus needing to complete the remaining 20% during the summer.
